- PAIX acquired by Switch and Data March 2003
- Expansion of Engineering resources
 - Focus on continued growth of Engineering department
- Profitable corporation
 - EBITDA positive performance since November 2001
 - Cash flow positive since May 2003

- 12th anniversary of first interconnection at Palo Alto Internet Exchange
 - Currently over 130 unique peers in Palo Alto alone
 - Growing access to Bay Area MetroPAIX fabric from other locations
- 10 Switch and Data Exchanges in North America
 - Atlanta, Dallas, Los Angeles, New York, Northern Virginia (Vienna),
 Palo Alto, Philadelphia, San Jose, San Francisco, & Seattle
- Ethernet-based switching services
 - 10Mb, 100Mb, 333Mb, 1000Mb ports
