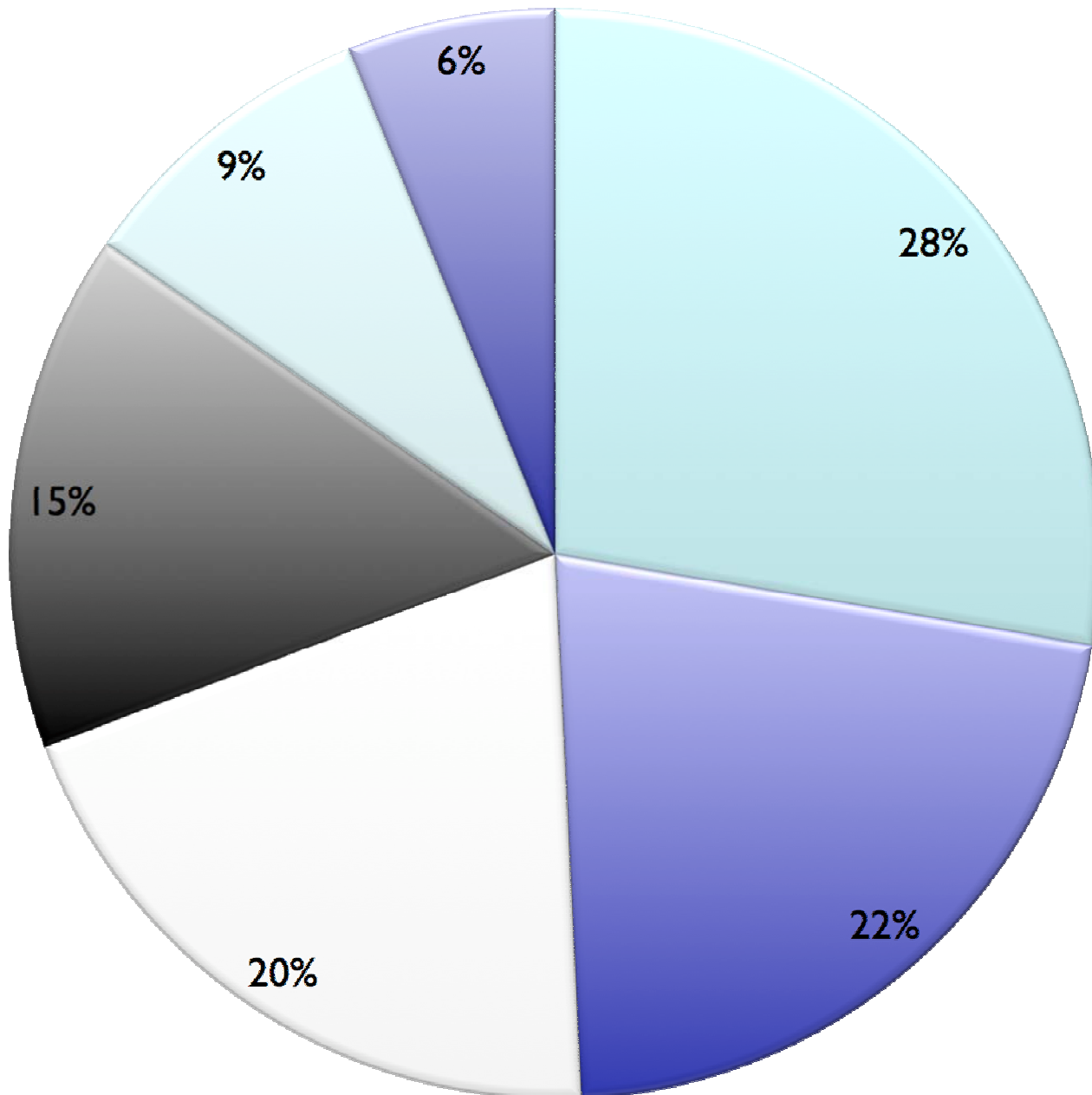

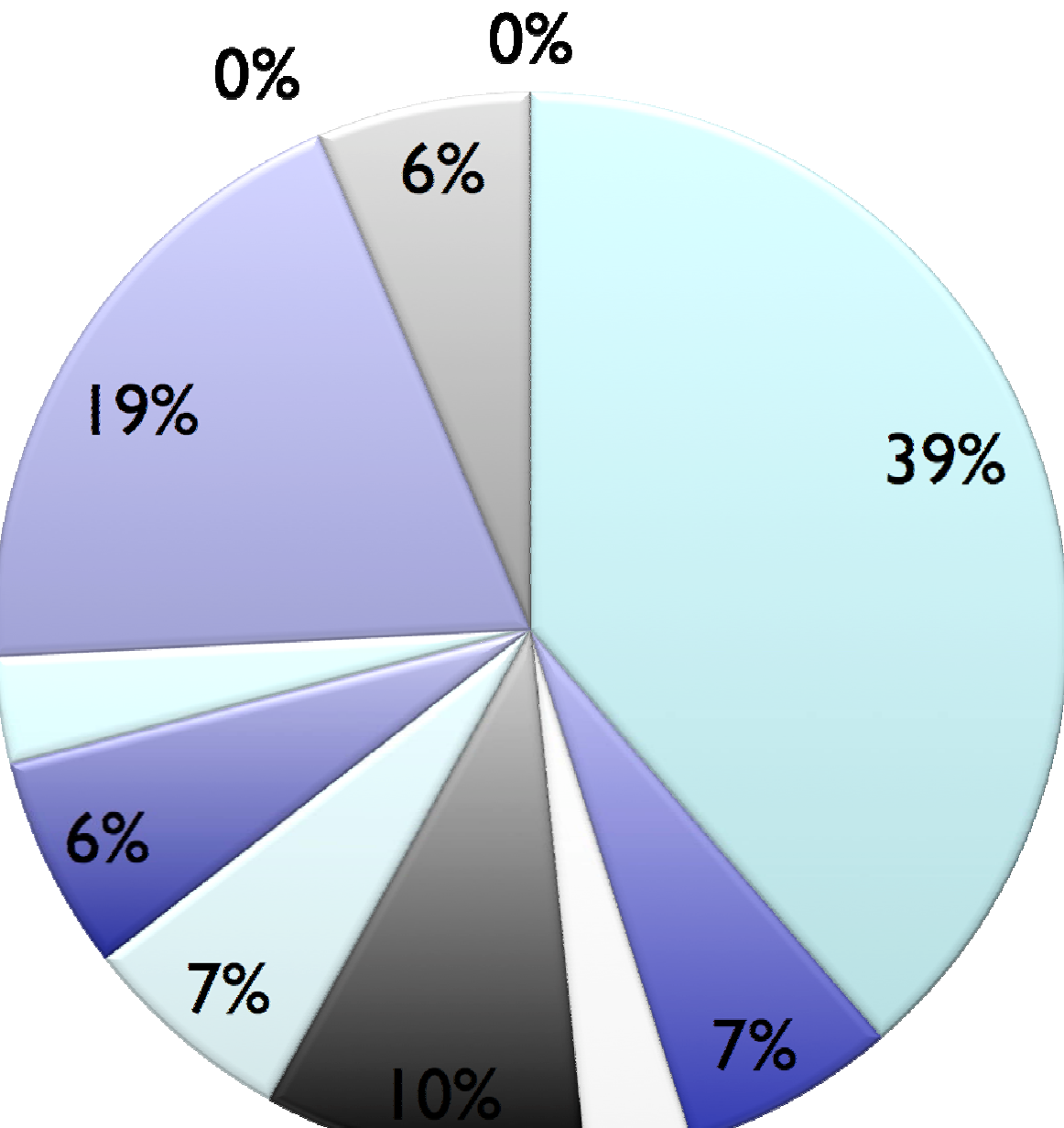

Network Presence

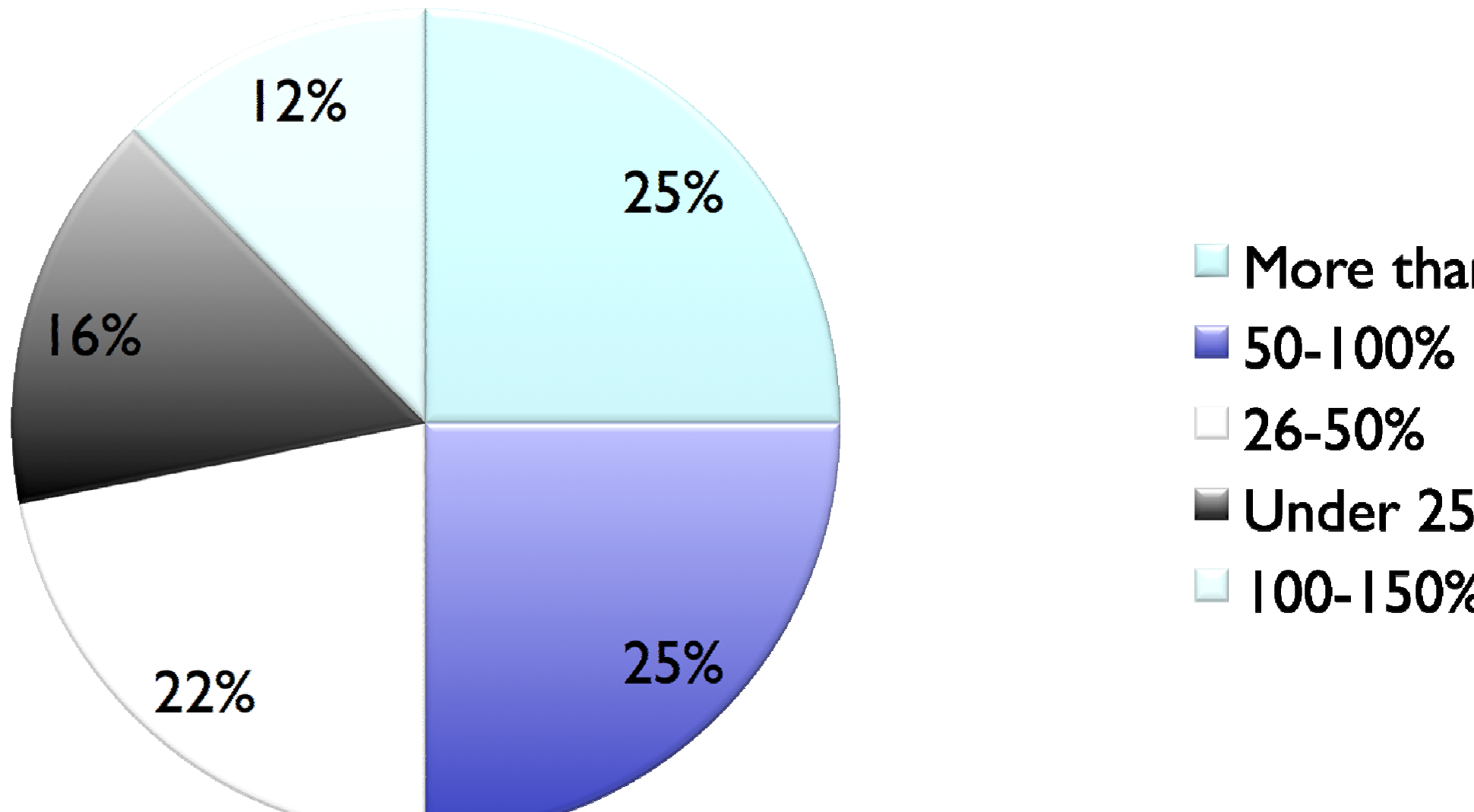

- 1:1 1 Mb in for every 1 Mb out < ratios
- 1:10 1 Mb in for every 10 Mbs o
- 1:2 2 Mbs OUT for every 1 Mb i
- 1:20 1 Mb in for every 20 Mbs o greater
- 1:3 1 Mb in for every 3 Mbs out
- 1:5 1 Mb in for every 5 Mbs out
- 10:1 10 Mbs in for every 1 Mb o
- 2:1 2 Mbs in for every 1 Mb out
- 20:1 20 Mbs in for every 1 Mb o more
- 3:1 3 Mbs in for every 1 Mb out
