
- Some history...
 - back in 1996 initial discussions about a RIR in the region
 - two different models. The most interesting one was focused on community.
 - new important players joined the idea in 1998. New other players were created at same period.
 - support for ICANN meeting in Chile, to present the idea



- Some history...
 - 1999, agreement for LACNIC creation signed among supporting organizations: ENRED, AHCIET, CABASE, ECOMLAC, NIC BRASIL, NIC MEXICO
 - Formal presentation to ICANN at meeting in Santiago, Chile
 - First meeting in Buenos Aires in 2000.
 - Hiring first staff in latter 2001 (nice offers!)

 - First office from april to november 2002 (12 m²):





- Some history...
 - Full operational at Jul 2002.
 - Formal recognition ICANN Meeting in Shanghai, Oct 2002. (Fun celebration ...)
 - Important lesson: hard work in politics lobby to harmonize different interests from different organizations. But it was well worth. Support from key organizations, very important!

- Regional Interconnection and IXP
 - Improve interconnection inside the region
 - NAPLA. Regional IXP forum
 - Support for projects
 - Policies for Internet Resource assignment
 - Very "hot" topic.



Internet Stability

- Root servers
 - +Raices (anycast F root servers copies).
 - Servers already installed: CL, AR, VE, PA, EC
 - Possible projects with other Root servers operators
 - Policies for Internet Resource assignment



Internet Stability

- IPv6 deployment
 - Promotion and training: IPv6Tour and tutorials at open forum. Portal for IPv6 information.
 - Campaigns: to have region ready by 1/1/20011.
 - Sponsorship for Task Force and regional forum
 - Another "hot" topic. Very related to IPv4 pool exhaustion.



Internet Stability and development

- Security
 - Mailing list and support for group meeting at open forum
 - Workshops and training
 - Support for Response Team formation
 - Project related to routing security (RPKI)



- Internet Governance discussion
 - Lot of discussion and lot of meetings/forums
 - global and regional
 - Internet as a important communication mechanism.
 - Concerns about its stability, growth, access, internationalization, from organizations and governments.



- Internet Governance discussion
 - Very active on global forums WSIS, IGF (part of MAG)
 - Participation at CITEL (Inter-american Telecommunication commission)
 - Despite other regular forums (ICANN, RIRs meeting, etc)



- Internet governance
 - RIRs for over 15 years responsibly and successfully stewardship IP distribution/management.
 - Successful bottom up policy process
 - Support and training activities to address needs and support Internet growth.
 - Also, space and discussions about IPv4 depletion, IPv6 deployment.



- Community coordination.
 - LACNOG. NOG community for the region
 - There are some (successful), groups in individual countries.
 - Create a space for network issue discussion and coordination at regional level
 - Space for presentation/discussion at LACNIC meetings. Topics presented at last meeting: routing aggregation in the region, RPKI, NTP.


