Akamai's v6 Day Plans



- Akamai is a CDN, we own no content
- Here to support customers, not push our own agenda
 - But we do understand v6 is critical to the Internet's future
- Working to make the transition as seamless as possible to customers and end users

Akamai's view on v6 Day



- Agree v6 Day is necessary
- Forces people to test what they believe will work
- Helps find & fix broken end users
- Will foster wider adoption (chicken – egg!)
- Last two points are huge barriers to global transition

Akamai's future v6 Strategy



- Plan to map "both" Internets
 - Correlating them is a monumental task
- Give users A or AAAA based on performance
 - May withhold AAAA if v4 performance is better
