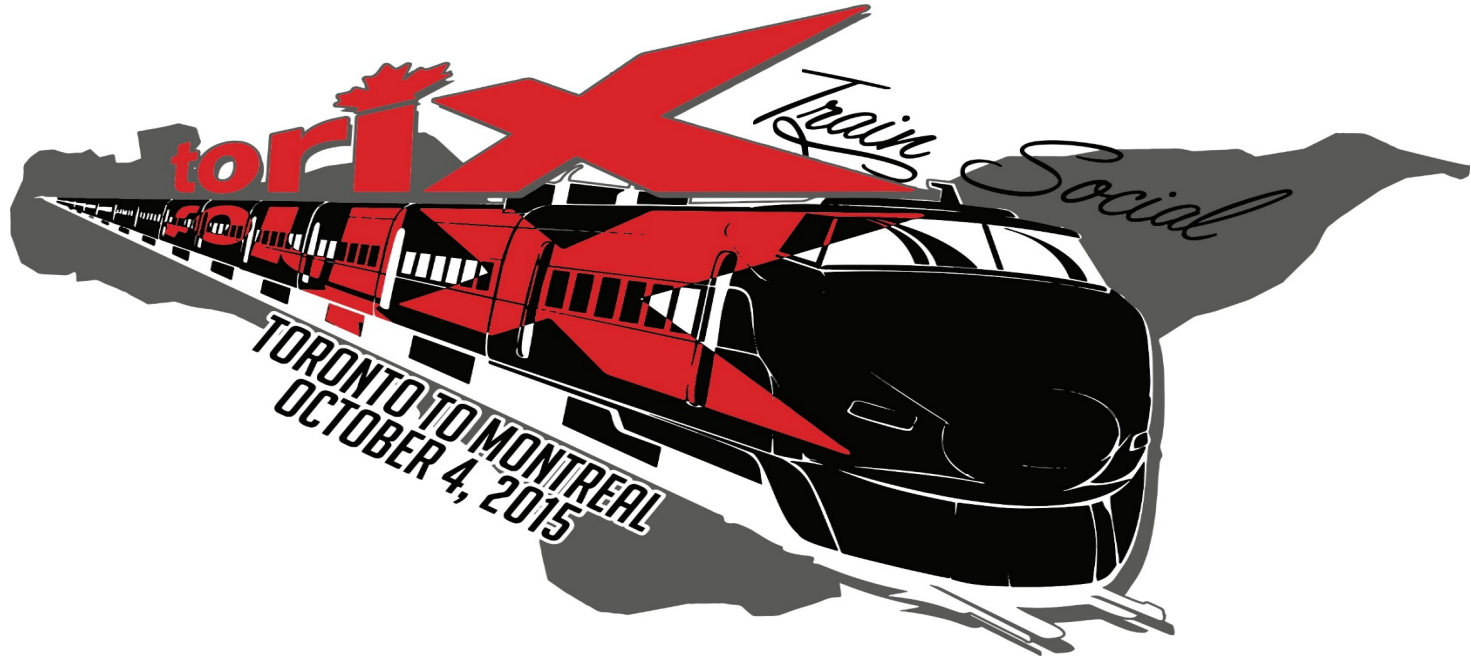

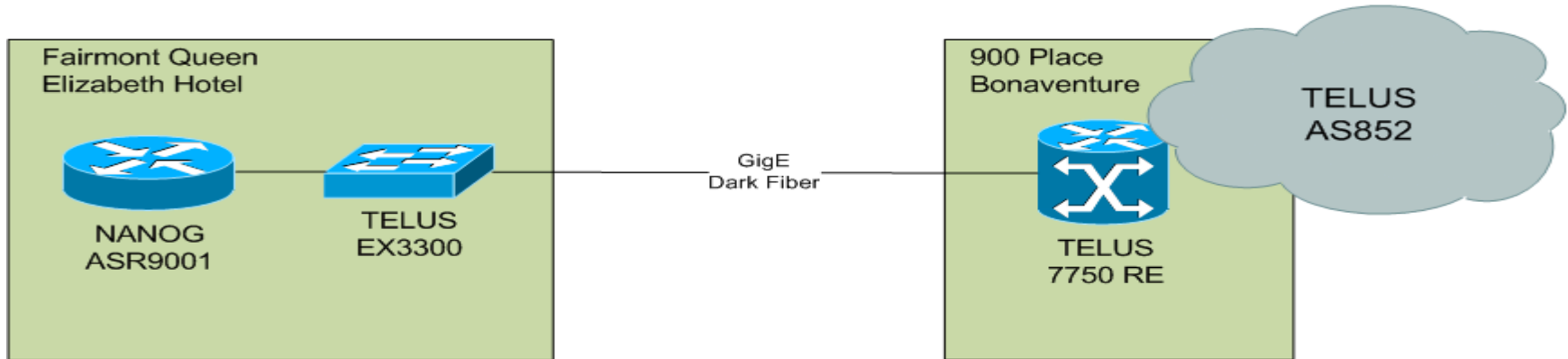
TELUS Overview

- TELUS has 1.5 million Internet and 954,000 IPTV subscribers between BC, Alberta, and eastern Quebec
- TELUS has 8.4 million wireless subscribers across our national HSPA/LTE network.
- Internet and data services are built across a 100GE MPLS core with dual-stack support.
- TELUS AS852 implements most of our Internet peering in Seattle Westin, Chicago Equinix, and New York (two locations).
- TELUS announced plans in June to deploy fiber to 300,000 Edmonton, AB homes and businesses using GPON technology



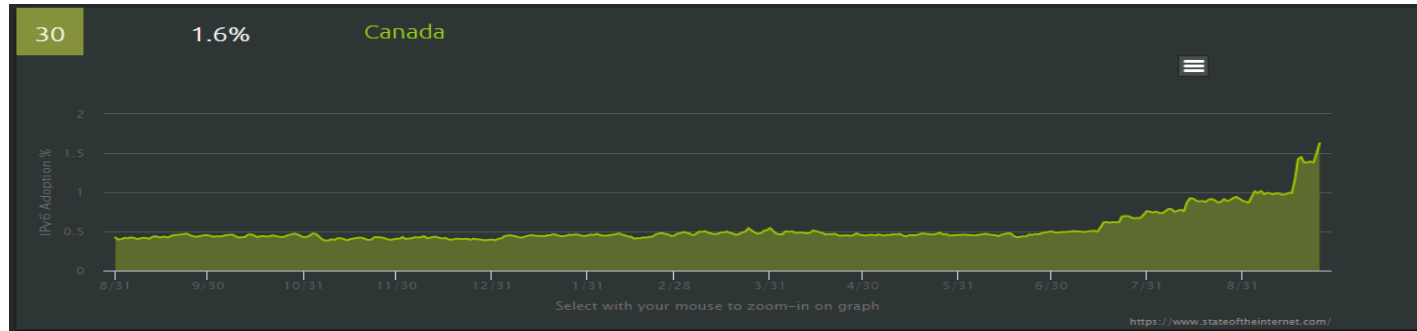

- The Canadian IPV6 usage has increased from 0.5% to 1.6% during July – Oct (source Akamai).



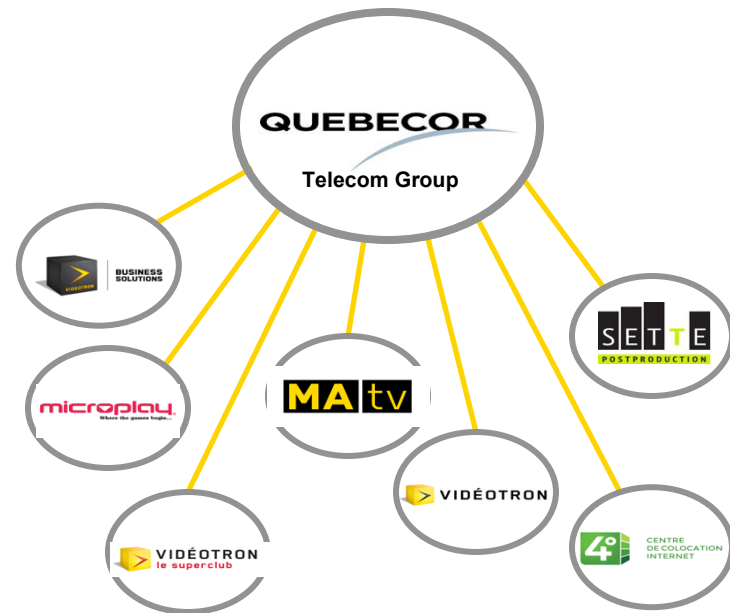

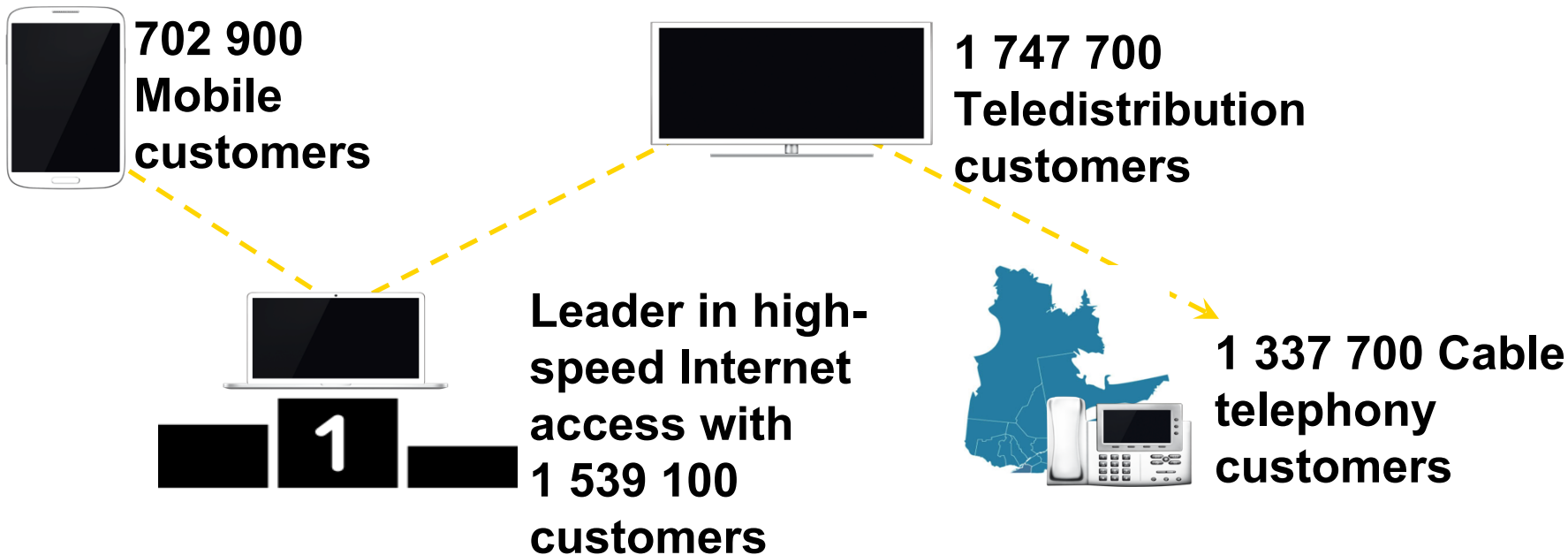

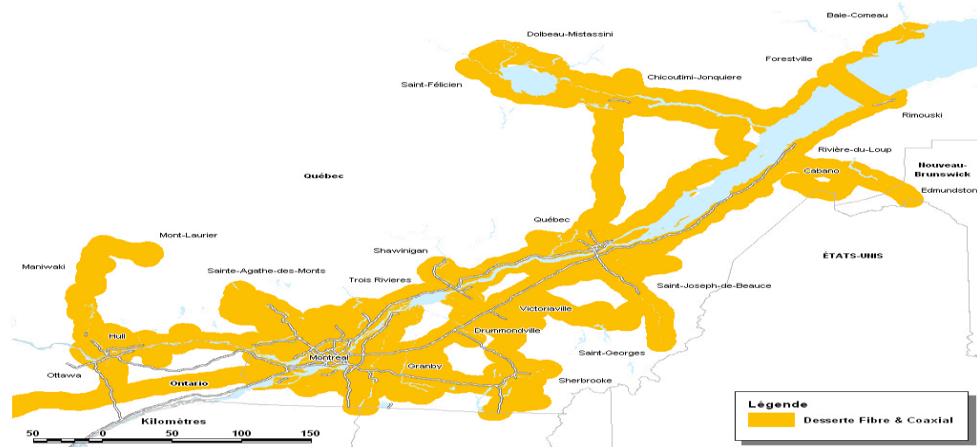
