



- "Throughout its entire history, the Internet system has employed a central Internet Assigned Numbers Authority (IANA)"
- IANA handles the central registries for the Internet –
 - "Names" (The DNS root zone)
 - "Numbers" (The IPv4, IPv6, ASN global free pools)
 - "Protocol Parameters" (port numbers, type codes, etc.)
- IANA services are provided under two agreements:
 - USG NTIA IANA Functions Contract with ICANN
 - RFC 2860 MOU between IAB/IETF and ICANN



Globalization of IANA Functions

 US Govt announced plan to transition oversight of the IANA functions contract



from NTIA to the "global multistakeholder community"



NTIA Conditions for Transition Proposal

- Support and enhance the multistakeholder model
- Maintain the security, stability, and resiliency of the Internet DNS
- Meet the needs and expectation of the global customers and partners of the IANA services
- Maintain the openness of the Internet



USG/NTIA will not accept government-based proposal





IANA Stewardship Transition Coordination Group






IANA Stewardship Transition Coordination Group (ICG) Mission
